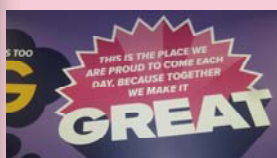
Welcome and Introduction to the meeting

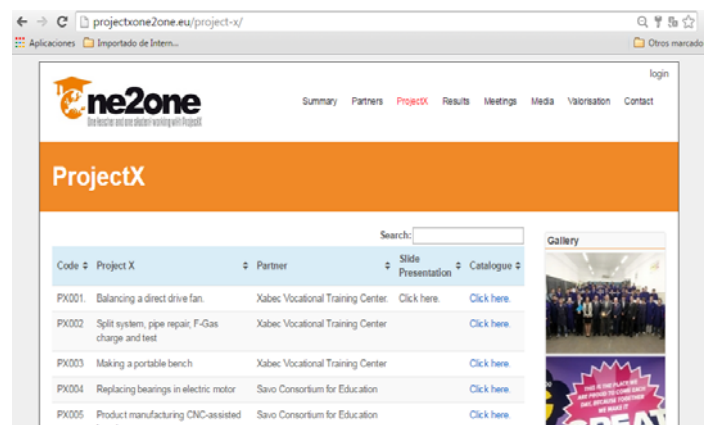

WS 2: ProjectX evaluation

Workshop 2, was a Skype presentation between the One2One Project participating country delegates and project coordinator from Spain Mr. Guillermo Ferrando and project evaluator Dr. Juan Manuel Mompó. Once the project evaluator had evaluated all of the projects he outlined his comments with regard to what aspects of the projects had been completed, some aspects that were irrelevant and

thus deleted and finally aspects of the project that need re-write/ modification. Once all the projects have been finalised, a booklet will be produced which will be written in a very simple format so that any student can follow the guidelines in the booklet and perform the project.

Once all the projects have been standardised they will be uploaded onto a portal where staff, students, parents and employers can have access to them. It is important to note that the One2One Project needs to be transnational therefore all the results are available in English.

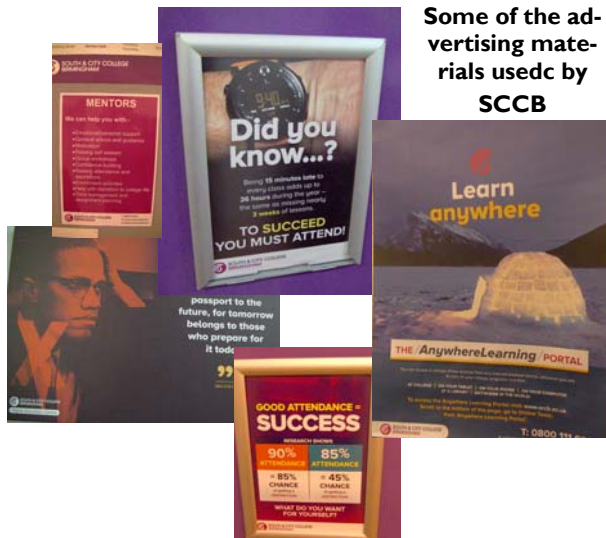
