Project Overview

"One teacher and one student working with ProjectX" (one2one) is a Leonardo da Vinci Transfer of Innovation Project. A "ProjectX" is a methodological guide for the student to carry out a concrete activity, one to one with the teacher, in which theory and practice are both perfectly integrated and is related to the real workplace.

Each ProjectX will be developed on the basis of Learning Outcomes, which means we will also create a tool based in the ECVET credit system that will allow mobility of students between the participating institutions. In this way we are aligned with the European Strat-

egy 2020 which boosts the mobility of students and teachers in a high grade of quality.

Each partner will develop three ProjectX and will run a pilot test using them. Other schools will validate the common ProjectX so they can also use them in its own school. Each ProjectX will include the units of Learning Outcomes in order to facilitate in the future mobility of students and teachers. In this way we will start a network of schools using this methodology that can grow by including in the future new schools and new ProjectX.

The kick-off meeting of the one2one project was held in SAVO college, located in Kuopio. Kuopio is a city and a municipality located in the region of Northern Savonia (Finland), being the eighth biggest city in the country and well known for their education centres, winter sports and it is known as the cultural centre of west Finland.

Mr. Markku Jokela, Development Director at the Savo Consortium for Education welcomed all the participants and presented the consortium and Savo Vocational College.

In the first working session, participants introduced themselves and the colleges they represent. Afterwards there was an overview of the

Mrs. Mariamar Cervantes from Xabec presented a general overview of the project. An explanatory document was distributed to each organization, in order to provide written information for all participants. It included a detailed description of the work packages, the tasks and results expected, as well as the

deadlines.

The importance of dissemination was stressed by participants: it is important for the EU to present the citizens the benefit for them by EU-projects and help other institutions to take advantage of the results of developing projects.

Each school has one rep-

resentative in the steering group that is in charge of the overall progress of the project. Each partner has a representative in the technical board that is in charge of the development of the project and in the management group which is in charge of the finances and reports of the project.







Technical Management

The objective of this work -shop was to explain in depth all the steps that partners need to take in order to accomplish the technical objectives of the project.

The team discussed about their different VETsystems. They agreed to use the EU-guidelines as reference for learning outcomes, independent from the way of vocational training in their countries.

During the presentation, The ProjectX methodology was described as it is used now in Xabec. It is a tool to create workshop projects that a student can do during mobility. During this session, the ToP MoSt project was presented in order to show available learning outcomes in which the ProjectX can be based.
