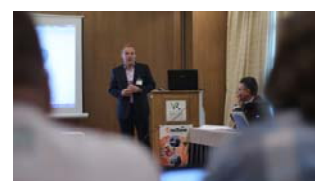


**Workshop 1: Presentation of Results Wp2 and WP3**

Mr. Ari Tolvanen presented the result of WP2 “Research and Analysis Report”. The report has two main parts. The first part is devoted to introduce the main aspects of the Finnish Educational System, which is recognised as one of the most effective VET systems in the world. It promotes lifelong learning and it doesn’t have any close-ends, so a person can go from one stage to the

next one in his/her own rhythm and needs. The Second part presents the main characteristics of the VET systems of participants’ countries. Obviously each country has its main characteristics, for example in Spain the Ministry defines part of the curricula and regions add specific subjects according to the local needs. Institutions are impelled to design own curricula if they want to

teach in dual system. The report concludes that there aren’t any obstacles that difficult the implementation of the methodology that the project is designing to teach using ProjectX.



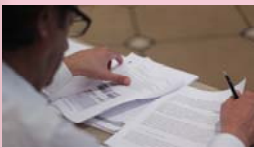

ticipants. The different templates to be used were explained and also the following deadlines. For the financial reports. Thanks Mariamar.



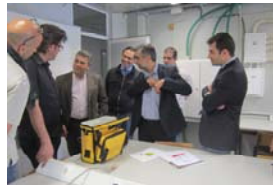
